Entry Fees: £3.00 per animal (to include penning) payable to DDSBA. Entry Fees to accompany the entry form. ENTRIES CLOSE 11 JUNE 2011

Terms of Sale: 5% commission to the Seller, no Buyer's premium. Any Stock sold after the Auction will need to be booked through the Auctioneers. No Registered Ram Lamb or Shearling Ram shall be sold by Auction at less than the upset price of £250.00.

Inspection: All sheep forward will be subject to Inspection and the Committee reserves the right to restrict entries or the sale of any animal/s if the need arises.

Numbering: All sheep to be numbered with paint applied with a numbering iron. The Association reserves the right to levy a charge for any unmarked or incorrectly numbered animal forward.

CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. All sheep to be accompanied by licence AML1 – obtained from your Local Authority (Trading Standards)
2. The whole of GB is now part of a Lower Risk Zone for Bluetongue (BTV8). Livestock owners in GB can continue to vaccinate as normal. For further information please refer to www.defra.gov.uk or Defra help line 08459 335577
3. All sheep must be tagged in accordance with the Sheep and Goats (Records, Identification and Movement) Order 2010
4. CLEANSE & DISINFECT (C&D)
All vendors bringing stock must comply with the Cleansing and Disinfection Order 2003 – i.e. they must CLEANSE AND DISINFECT their vehicle either by using the facilities provided at the Venue or by thoroughly cleansing the vehicles upon reaching home – within 24 hours.
5. PROTECTIVE CLOTHING/BOOTS
No Vendors, their staff or agents will be allowed within the livestock holding pens unless wearing the correct clean protective clothing which includes Wellington Boots and/or rubber soled work boots, smock/overalls or waterproof coats and leggings that can be cleansed and sprayed down.
6. ALL BIO SECURITY MEASURES MUST BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO.
